
Fredericksburg [undeciphered month] 11th 1780.
The bearer Thomas Adams a soldier in the fifth Virginia regiment having served three years the full term of his enlistment is now discharged from the service and is intitled to the bounty of land granted by the state for that [undeciphered word] of service.
