This may certify that Peter Bowles has not Drew the sute of Cloaths promised the soldiers 2<sup>d</sup> Virg'a State Reg't by an act of Gen'l Assembly Previous to there march to the northward.

I Do Assign the Above to Capt. Jo'n Fox [Jonathan Fox] Peter hisXmark Boles [undeciphered signature] Nath'l Welch Capt [Nathaniel Welch R18894] 2<sup>d</sup> Virg'a State Reg't May 2<sup>d</sup> 1780 [last digit unclear]

At a Quarterly Court Continued and held for King and Queen County at the Court house on Wednesday the 15<sup>th</sup> of March 1815.

William Fleming appeared in Court and made oath that Peter Bowles served for three years as a private in the Second Virginia Regiment in the Revolutionary War with Great Britain that he the said Bowles served in the same Company with him, and was attached to the same Regiment
