I do hereby certify that John Bradley was a private in the 5 Virg Regiment prior to the first of January One Thousand seven hundred and seventy seven was appointed a Sergeant in February or March follow'g the particular day I do not recollect and served in that capacity till some in the month of March one thousand seven hundred Eighty when he was killed in a sirmish [skirmish] near Stono [Stono River] in South Carolina he drew his pay from the pay master the Month of July 1778 [last digit could be 6] and from May 1779.
