By Virtue of the order of the Hon'bl Mag'r G'l Greene [Major General Nathanael Greene] the Bearer hereof Benj'n Bragg of the fifth troop Rig't [Regiment] Light Dragoons Com'd by Colo George Baylor has leave to be absent from Said Rig't till Call'd for then to repair to Such Rendenvous as Shall be appointed in the Stait of Virginia under pain of being Considered and Treated as a deserter the Summons being published in the Virginia News papers three weeks successively to be considered as Sufficient notis given at Hampton this 10th day of July 1783

I do Certify that Beng'n Bragg Inlisted in the first Reg't of Dragoons the nineteenth day of June 1780 [possibly 1781] for during the war and that he only Received four hundred and forty five Dollars of his Bounty which was to been seven hundred and fifty the Ballance due him three hundred and five and his perpsion [proportion?] of Land Given from under my hand 4th april 1784
