Mecklenburg County Court 1[?]th November 1811

It appearing to the satisfaction of the Court from the evidence of William Allen [VAS2222], Elisha Winn [S38477] & Philip Snead [S38392] who are men of respectable standing [one or two undeciphered words], and who were sworn for that purpose That Stephen Brown, Jacob Brown, Young Stokes, William Colley, John Ragsdale [undeciphered] Philip Bowers, Isham Hungerford, Anselm Bailey, Hugh Wallace [S41306], were soldiers, regularly enlisted and served under Capt James Johnson, in the late revolutionary war, in the sixth Virginia Regiment for two years. Thereupon the same is ordered to be certified to the executive of this Commonwealth.

And it also appearing to the satisfaction of the Court from the evidence of s'd Elisha Winn & Philip Snead who were sworn for that purpose, That Benjamin Snead, Israel Snead, John Wilkinson, Parsons Wright & Robert Farguson were soldiers also & enlisted also in the same manner, served under the same Captain & in the same Regiment, thereupon the same is ordered to be certified as above.
