William Buchannan enlisted With me 22^{nd} August 1777 to serve three years in State Artillery as Drummer. Wm Jennings [William Jennings R15422], former/ Capt. in S. Artillery A Copy Phil Southall

William Buchannan Was kill'd in North Carolina [sic] in the Battle fought when Gen'l. Gates Was defeated, in the year 1780, August [defeat of Gen. Horatio Gates at the Battle of Camden SC, 16 Aug 1780]. Given under my hand 12th Nov'r 1783. Peter Kemp [VAS2172] Capt. S. A A Copy Phil. Southall

Mr. William Brough is hereby empowr'd to receive & adjush[?] whatever may be due my late Husband Wm Buchanan who was kill'd in North Carolina in the states service. 3^d April 1784 Test/ Wm Jennings
