To His Excellency David Campbell, Gov. of Virg'a. [11 Jan 1839]

Your Memorialist Francis Manuel of Fauq'r. [Fauquier] County for himself and other heirs of James Bryant, who was a soldier during the American Revolution, and belonged to Gen'l Clarks [George Rogers Clark VAS269] Army, respectfully prays that the land bounty due by Virginia for the revolutionary services of s'd James Bryant may be allowed and that Warrants may be issued therefor by the Register of the land office.
