I do Certify that William Burge enlisted some time in the year 1776 (about Feb'y) & in decem'r. 1776 he was appointed Serjeant Major in the 7th Vir. Reg't. & continued till Decem'r. 1777 & then reenlisted & died in service.

Entitled to depreciation as Serj't Major from 1st Han'y 1777 to Dec'r 1778 If not settled. Aug't 29 1787
