I hereby Certifie that I enlisted Millington Burnett in March 1777 & that the said Burnett was to serve in one of the State Regiments for three y'rs as Witness my hand this 10 June 1786
B C Spiller [Benjamin C. Spiller] Capt 2^d State Regiment

Intitled to depreciation from 1st May 1777 to the first June 1778 as a private from thence to the last of December 1778 as a Corporal. June 13 1786 T. Meriwether

I have Empowered Rich'd Burnett to settle the Claims of my late Brother Millington Burnett
Given under my hand 1st of June 1786 Elisha hisXmark Burnett
Test Rich'd Chapman
