William Brent [VAS2639] of Frederick Burris having served as a Soldier three years in the second State Regiment, the Term of his Enlistment, And another Certificate from Sam'l Griffin a Justice of James City County, of the said Burriss having made Oath before him that he never before proved or claimed his Right to Land for his said Military Service were produced & read & ordered to be certified & recorded [undeciphered signature] CC
