
By Virtue of the orders of the Honorable Major Gen [Nathanael] Greene Jesse Chandler – The bearer hereof belonging to the third Troop of the first Regiment of Dragoons commanded by Colo George Baylor [W5966] has leave of absence from his said Regiment till call'd for and then to repair to such rendezvous as shall be appointed in the state of Virginia under pain of being considered and treated as deserter. The said summon being published in the Virginia Gazette three weeks successively to be [one or two undeciphered words] sufficient notice.

[undeciphered] 12<sup>th</sup> June 1783.
