The affidavit of Moses Self [W19009] of the County of Westmoreland & State of Virginia aged seventy years, taken this 7th day May 1832. This affiant being first sworn says he well recollects William Chilton enlisted in the Continental Service for three years, under a certain Capt. Holland Haynie he believes & that the said Chilton served that period further this affiant says not. Moses hisXmark Self

NOTE: According to John H. Gwathmey's *Historical Register of Virginians in the Revolution*, Holland Haynie was in the 1st Artillery Regiment as 2nd Lt. in Capt. Nathaniel Burwell's company from 21 Oct 1777 and then 1st Lt. in Capt. Thomas Baytop's company from 30 Nov. 1777 until the end of the war.
