

I do Certiye that I Enlisted Joseph Cook som Time in the yeare 1776 to serve in my company In the first
Virg'a Reg't as A Soldier for the War who was Wounded in the Battle of German Town [Germantown, 4
Oct 1777] of which wound he Died.

Given under my hand this 4th day of June 1780.
