At a Court held for James City County June the 12th 1780

A Certificate from Col'n J. Allison [John Allison W4112] of William Creekman having served three years as a Soldier in the first State Regiment, the Term of his Enlistment, And another certificate from Sam'l Griffis a Justice of James City County & of the said Creekman's having made oath before him that he never before proved or claimed his Right to Land for his said military services were produced & read & ordered to be certified & recorded
