I use speech recognition software to make all my transcriptions. Such software misinterprets my southern accent with unfortunate regularity and my poor proofreading fails to catch all misinterpretations. Also, dates or numbers which the software treats as numerals rather than words are not corrected: for example, the software transcribes "the eighth of June one thousand eighty six" as "the 8th of June 1786." Please call errors or omissions to my attention.]

I do hereby Certify that Reuben Odell enlisted the latter end of 1776 as a private in the 12th Virginia Regiment for three years after serving the first year he was drafted into the Corps what served as the Generals Guard where he continued till the expiration of his enlistment when he enlisted for the war in Col. Proctors [?]¹ Regt. of Artillery.
