

Prince William county State of Virginia/ Oct'r 3rd 1832

I hereby Certify that I Hugh Davis [S10136] aged Seventy Four years well knew John Davis Dec'd formerly of said County and well know that he Enlisted in the Continental Virginia State Line for the Term of Three years During the Revolutionary Warr, and that he marched from said County under the Command of Capt. Andrew Leach and that he the said John Davis Departed this Life at the Town of Philidelphia of the Small Pox and at the time of his Death he was attached to the Service of the said State. he said Davis Left William Davis his only Heir he the said William Davis regularly Transferred all his right and Interest that John Davis was entitled to Land due him from the State Virginia unto Jesse Davis and he the said Jesse Davis has Transferred his Interest unto Hugh Davis
