S'r pleas to Deliver to Mr [undeciphered] Almond A Certeficate for my propotion of Land as you will
see Allowed me for my service [several undeciphered words]
Colo [Thomas] Meriwether and you will Much oblige/ yr H[rest undeciphered]

July 27 1782

Certified that Spill Davis entered in to the army the 15th day of November 1777 as a Serjeant for the term
of three years that he reenlisted in the year 1779 for the War and that he has continued in the army as a
Serjeant to this date Given under my hand July 21st 1783
