I do Certify that Moses Olliver Enlisted the 20<sup>th</sup> of May 1781 as a Soldier in the Virginia Continental line and as appears by Captain Booker's Certificate served until discharged, 2<sup>nd</sup> April 1785 S/Wm Darke

Colo. in Virginia Line

Agreeable to a Resolution of Congress bearing Date the 26<sup>th</sup> day of May 1783 the bearer here of Moses Olliver Matross of the 1<sup>st</sup> artillery Regiment has leave of Absence until called upon by proper authority to join his Corps or is finally Discharged

The above mentioned Moses Olliver was listed for the War pr. Capt. Lewis Booker's Muster Roll the time is expressed in Colo. Dark's discharge
