I do Certify that Ellis Devine of [undeciphered] Enlisted the first day of April one thousand seven hundred & seventy seven for three years in the Eleventh Virginia [undeciphered word] and died the 16th of October following Given under my hand this fifteenth day of [undeciphered] 1785

Geo Rice [George Rice BLWt1786-300] late
Capt in the 11th [undeciphered]

A handwritten signature in cursive script, appearing to read "Geo Rice".

Richard Farmer of Jefferson County Ohio enlisted in 1778 or 1779 for two years in the 13th Regiment of Virginia troops commanded by Col. Gibson [John Gibson S41578] in Capt. Andrew Ferrel's Company & was discharged by Gen. [Nathanael] Greene after the surrender of Cornwallis [at Yorktown, 19 Oct 1781].

He wishes for a warrant for his bounty lands from Virginia.

The heirs of Ellis Devine also want a warrant for his bounty lands. Enclosed you have the certificate of his Captain endorsed by Gen. Daniel Morgan. Any fees you may have to pay I will refund to you.
