[The following are from [bounty-land records in the Library of Virginia](#) indexed as Divens, William in two files clearly pertaining to the same soldier.]

These are to Certify that William Diven Formerly a Sergant in the 10th Virginia Ridgement has duly faithfully served the Turm of three years for which he was Inlisted in Consequence of which and at his at his own request he is hereby Dischardged from any further service in the army of the united States and purmitted to Return to his home free & unmolisted – he having Received all his Bounty Pay & Cloathing and Deficiencis of Cloathing in full of all allowances and Provision maid by the Congress for their Troops his Receipt for which is on the back hereof.

Given under my hand at Phillidilphia this 4th day of Feb’y 1780
