July 19th 1784

I do Certify that Francis Dyer inlisted into my Company belonging to Colo Harrison [sic: Charles Harrison VAS1411] Reg't of Artillery the 1th day of [undeciphered] 1777 for the Term of three years & served the above term faithfully
