Philip Finn a Soldier in Col Gibsons [John Gibson S41578] Comp'y 9<sup>th</sup> Virg. Reg't. who was Inlisted for the term of three years to serve in the Continental Army & has serv'd his time out as a good & faithfull Soldier & is now entitled to his discharge and is hereby discharged accordingly—Given under my hand at Fort Pitt Ap'l. 18<sup>th</sup> 1784
