At a Court held for James City County Sept'r 11th 1780

A certificate from Col J. Allison [John Allison W4112] of Arthur Graham having served as a Soldier three years in the first Virginia State Regiment And another Certificate from Robert Andrews a Justice of the said County of the said Graham having made Oath before him of his never before proving or claiming his Right to Land for the Service aforesaid, were produced read & ordered to be certified and recorded
