



I do hereby Certifie that I ship'd Dan'l Grant in the navy as a Seaman the 25th day of March 1776 on Board the Schooner Hornitt [sic: *Hornet*] who Continued as a Seaman untill June 15th 1777 s'd Dan'l. Grant was then appointed Gunners Mate & Continued in the Ship Tarter [sic: *Tartar*] till 1779 Aug't 18th.
