We do hereby Certify that we knew John Graves as a officer in the last Revolutionary War with great Brittain he Entered into Service in the year 1776 on the 13<sup>th</sup> January and Continued until after the Seige of York [28 Sep - 19 Oct 1781] as a Capt & Mager [sic: Major] he Commanded in the Eigth Virginia Ridgement on Continental Establishment Given under oure hands this fifth day of June [undeciphered year] B Porter Major [Benjamin Porter VAS242]

It does not appear that John Graves has drawn a Warrant for the land bounty, as an officer, [several undeciphered words] John Graves for his services as a private during the war.
