## Bounty Land Warrant information relating to Patrick Martin VAS Transcribed by Will Graves

I use speech recognition software to make all my transcriptions. Such software misinterprets my southern accent with unfortunate regularity and my poor proofreading fails to catch all misinterpretations. Also, dates or numbers which the software treats as numerals rather than words are not corrected: for example, the software transcribes "the eighth of June 1786." Please call errors or omissions to my attention.]

## Richmond March 6 1784

I do Certify that Patrick Martin enlisted in the First Regiment of Artillery in the month of November 1782 to serve the Term of Nine years & by a late resolution of Congress is discharged the Service of the United States.
