Also, dates or numbers which the software treats as numerals rather than words are not corrected: for example, the software transcribes "the eighth of June one thousand eighty six" as "the 8th of June 1786." This is to Certified that Benjamin Mathews enlisted for three years in the 15th Virginia Regiment the first day of January 1777 and served his time out as a good and faithful Soldier [indecipherable 2 lines of text damaged and illegible] then in August 4 1777, for 1778, June received eight months pay & three in September, do then for October, November, & December.
