Only materials pertinent to the military service of the veteran and to contemporary events have been transcribed. Affidavits that provide additional information on these events are included and genealogical information is abstracted, while standard, 'boilerplate' affidavits and attestations related solely to the application, and later nineteenth and twentieth century research requests for information have been omitted. I use speech recognition software to make all my transcriptions. Such software misinterprets my southern accent with unfortunate regularity and my poor proofreading fails to catch all misinterpretations. Also, dates or numbers which the software treats as numerals rather than words are not corrected: for example, the software transcribes "the eighth of June one thousand eighty six" as "the 8th of June 1786." Please call errors or omissions to my attention.]

David Meriwether claim for 7 years bounty in land allowed January 20 1803 issued

At the request of General David Meriwether I certify that he enlisted in the rifle company of Captain Thomas Walker of the 9<sup>th</sup> Virginia Regiment then commanded by Colonel Thomas Fleming on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of March in the year 1776. Given under my hand at the Federal City this 23 December 1802

S/ Mat. Clay, late Lieut. 9 Virga Regt.

I do certify that Lieutenant David Meriwether was appointed paymaster to my Regiment the 5<sup>th</sup> Day of November 1779. Given under my hand this 13<sup>th</sup> day of December 1779
