These are to Certify that the bearer hereof Spencer Cooper Corp'l in the first Artillery Regim't, having faithfully served the United States from the 2<sup>d</sup> of June 1780 to this date and being enlisted for the War, is hereby discharged from the American army.

Given at the War office the 5<sup>th</sup> of July 1783 By order of the Secretary of War,/ Jos. Carleton Sec'y B Lincoln [Gen. Benjamin Lincoln]
