I James Cunningham aged Eighty-one years do upon oath testify and declare that in the year 1778 I Enlisted for the term of during the war & served in the Regiment No five under the Command of Colonel [Charles] Scott of the Virginia line and that I continued in the servis aforesaid until The close of the war when I was regularly discharged From the said Regiment commanded by colonel Scott I further declare that I have never received a warrant for the Bounty Land promised to me on the part of the united states; nor have I Ever assigned or Transfered my claim in any maner whatsoever: Therefore [Power of attorney to Leroy Jordan of Bedford County VA follows.]
