State of Virginia County of Bedford

I John Green son and one of the heirs at law of John Green Deceas'd do upon oath testify and declare to the best of my knowledge and belief that John Green did enlist in the year 1776 for the term of during the war and served in [Henry] Lee's Legion under the command of Col Lee on continental establishment, and that he continued in the service aforesaid until the close of the war in 1783. I further declare that I have never received a warrant for the bounty land promised to John Green on the part of the United States, nor do I believe that he ever received it or transfered his claim to it in any manner whatsoever. Virginia To Wit

At a court held for Bedford County the 24th day of November 1828. Satisfactory evidence was adduced in court to prove that William Green, John Green and Nancy Green are the children and only heirs at law in fee to John Green Deceased late a Soldier in Lees Legion on Continental Establishment
