Va. Bowne Thomas B.L.Wt.259-300 – Capt. Issued Oct. 28, 1789 to Mathew McConnell, assignee/ No papers.

From the best information I can obtain Captain Thomas Bowne was appointed Adjutant to the first regiment in October 1776 and acted till Sep'r 1777 as [illegible word] much longer I cannot ascertain [several illegible words] March 1783 [signed] William Davies Col.

I do hereby Certify that Captain Thomas Bowne entered into the service of the United States in the latter end of the year 1775 or beginning of the year 1776, & Continued in Service until the Arrangement of December 1782 when he became a redundant Officer liable to be again called into service, and that he is entitled to all the emoluments to Officers serving to the End of the war.

Given under my hand this 3^d day of December 1795.
