Bounty Land Warrant of Alexander Brackenridge BLWt287-300

This may Certify that Alex'r Breckenridge enlisted Commissioned Lieut. in Colo. Gists
[Nathaniel Gist's] Reg't Virg'a the 14th of March 1777 and served as such until the 23^d April 1779 from
which time he was Commissioned to a Cap'tn and served as such till this date.
May 22^d 1783 [Peter Muhlenberg Brigadier General]
