On this 25th day of June A.D. one thousand eight hundred and sixty personally appeared before me a justice of the peace within and for the county and state aforesaid Joseph Aldridge aged about sixty seven a resident of the County of Prairie in the State of Arkansas who being duly sworn according to law declares that he is the only son & surviving heir of Peter Aldridge who was a volunteer private in the company commanded by Captain Farquhar of North Carolina in the Revolutionary war and continued in actual service in said war for the time of over six months & was honorably discharged when peace was made. He makes this declaration for the purpose of obtaining the bounty land to which he may be entitled under the act approved March 3^d. 1855 He also declares that he has not received a warrant for bounty land under this or any other act of Congress nor made any other application therefor
