Kentucky Frankfort May 30th 1810

I do certify that James Craig was in February 1776 appointed a second Lieutenant in Captain James Knox's Company [raised in Fincastle County] of the 8<sup>th</sup> Regment Virginia on Continental establishment and continued in the service until the fall of the year 1778 at which time he was arranged as a Supernumerary Captain [with insufficient troops for a command] in the arrangement of the Army at White Plains [14 Sep 1778]

Joseph Crockett Late Maj'r of 7<sup>th</sup> Virginia Reg't

James Craig has drawn a Warrant for 4000 acres for his services as Captain three years in the Continental line. Chas Blagrove Regʻr
