5/24/1776, a Surgeon. Resigned April 1777. Surgeon's Mate in 1st NC Regiment again on 2/21/1782. 4/24/1782, back in 2nd NC Regiment. A Surgeon again on 8/20/1782, till the end of the war. From Wilmington, NC. aka Janus Fergus, John Fergus.
