I certify that from an examination of the claim [not found in the file] of the Heirs of the late James Daughity, or Dougherty, dec'd. who was a Lieutenant in the Virginia State Navy, I am satisfied that he served till the reduction of said Navy in 1781; that he survived until the month of March eighteen hundred and thirty; and that James B. Daughity and the other Heirs mentioned in the accompanying papers, are entitled to the benefits of the act of the 5<sup>th</sup> of July 1832: I do therefore give it as my opinion that the claim should be paid to the Heirs from the twenty second of April seventeen hundred and eighty three until the first of March eighteen hundred and thirty, at the rate of one hundred and eighty two dollars and fifty cents per annum. I also certify that Vespasian Ellis and Thomas H. Harvey, of Virginia, as attorneys of Samuel B. Daughity, of the State of Mississippi, administrator of the deceased, are authorized to receive the amount due.
