Pension Application of Thomas Fox R14268 VA Half Pay Transcribed and annotated by C. Leon Harris. 24 Feb 2014.

[The federal half-pay file contains only a query dated 15 Nov 1852 about Capt. Thomas Fox and the following note: "No application for pension in the case of Capt Thomas Fox appears to have been filed in this office."

A Capt. Thomas Fox did apparently apply successfully for federal bounty land and was issued bounty-warrant BLWt765-300 for 300 acres on 17 July 1800. That file is also devoid of any original document. The following documents from bounty-warrant records in the Library of Virginia are assumed to be for those one or two Captains Thomas Fox.]

Winchester Barracks Dec'r 28th 1783.

I do hereby Certifie that Capt. Thomas Fox of the Virg'a. Line enter'd the Service the 4th day of Dec'r 1776 and is now in Actual Service.

I do hereby Certify that Capt Thomas Fox late of the Virginia line on Continental establishment was in the service some time in mid-summer of the year 1776 and continued in the same to the end of the war [William B. Wallace, pension application S42612]
