Pension Application of Hezekiah Collins R20343

For the purpose of obtaining the benefit of "An Act for the relief of certain surviving Officers and Soldiers of the Army of the Revolution" approved on the 15th of May 1828 I Hezekiah Collins of Union Township in the County of Madison & state of Ohio do hereby declair that I was a private soldier in the Continental line of the Army of the revolution & served as such to the end of the war at which period I was a private of the second reg of the Virginia line. That I enlisted from Albermarl Co. [sic: Albemarle County] Virginia in the year 1777 as near as I can recolect under a recruiting officer by the name of Dewit for the term of during the war & joined the fourth reg commanded I think by Col. Cambell [sic: Richard Campbell] That at the close of the war I was discharged by Gen. Green [sic: Nathanael Greene] in South Carolina I think at or near Camden.
