And I hereby relinquish every claim to a pension or annuity except the present & he declares that his name is not on the pension roll of any agency in any state. And deponent further swears that he was born in Henry County Virginia in the year 1760 [sic: Henry County formed from Pittsylvania County in 1766] that he has no record of his age And that John G. Park Esq. Rev'd Hosea Camp Archie R. Smith Esq. Coll N. L. Hutchins & every other person with whom he is acquainted will testify as to his character for veracity.
