Pension Application of John Scott S21474

The State of South Carolina Anderson District

On this fifth day of March 1833 personally appeared in open court before the Judge of the Court of Sessions & Common Pleas in the State aforesaid and for the said District now in Session — John Scott residing in the State & district aforesaid and who being duly sworn according to law, doth on oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the act of Congress passed June 7 1832

This Deponent was born in Lancaster County Pennsylvania in the year 1742 aged 92 years but has not record of it - he lived in Iredell County formed from Rowan County in 1788] North Carolina when he entered the service afterwards he moved into Anderson District South Carolina where he has been living thirty five years - he was drafted in 1780 under Capt Reed [probably Samuel Reid], Col. Geo. Alexander Gen'l. [Griffith] Rutherford holding the office of Issuing Commissary - dealing out & receiving provissions and so forth. He served under those officers until Gates Defeat [defeat of Gen. Horatio Gates at the Battle of Camden SC, 16 Aug 1780] when Rutherford was taken prisoner - when Gen'l. [William Lee] Davidson took the command - in 1781- he served under him until the British crossed the Catawba River under Cornwallis, Baties Ford [Beatties Ford]; he was at the defeat of Gates and also at the battle when the British crossed the river Catawba [skirmish at Cowan's Ford near Beatties Ford, 1 Feb 1781]. he served seven months altogether

he has never received a discharge nor any compensation for his services nor has he any other proof than what is here offered. He hereby relinquishes every claim whatever to a pension or annuity except the present and declares that his name is not on the Pension roll of the agency of any state.
