Pension Application of John Shehee (Conner) S36302 VA

Georgia } John Shehee came before me and on his oath saith that he enlisted as a Lincoln County } private soldier in the Revolutionary War under Capt. Labraugh [probably Francis Le Brun] in Pulaski's Troop [Kazimierz Pulaski's Legion of Horse and Foot] that after Pulaski was killed [mortally wounded at Siege of Savannah on 9 Oct 1779] he was commanded by one Col. Ormange [sic: Charles Armand] that this deponant served six years and received his discharge at little york [York] in Pensylvania which discharge has since been lost or distroyed that this deponant is now upwards of Eighty years of age and his circumstances so low as to render the assistance of his country necessary for his support.

Sworn to before me this 5 Janry 1819. John his Xmark Shehee [The certification states that John Shehee was "known by the name of John Conner."]

Personally appeard in open Court John Shehee, alias John Conner aged about seventy years or upwards resident in said County who being duly sworn according to Law Doth on his oath declare that he served in the revolutionary war in General Pulaskie's Troop of horse, that he has receivd a pension from the United States under act of Congress of the 18th of March 1818 and which Certificate bears date the tenth day of July 1819 and not numbered, and further Swears that he was a resident Citizen of the United States on the 18th day of March 1818 and that he has not since that time by gift sale or in any manner disposed of his property or any part thereof with intent thereby so to diminish it as to bring himself within the provisions of an act of Congress entitled "an act to provide for certain person engaged in the land and naval service of the United States in the Revolutionary War" passed on the 18th day of March 1818 and that he has not nor has any person in trust for him any property or securities contracts or debts due to him nor has he any income other than what is contained in the Schedule hereto annexed, and he further swears that he is blind and no occupation whereby he can support himself and that the number of his family is five, himself his wife, her boys about seventeen & fourteen & a daughter about 13 or fourteen years old
