Joshua Dunn, resident of Essex County Virg'a., aged sixty three years, deposeth & saith that he enlisted in the early part of the Revolutionary War, in the company of Capt. Rich'd. Stevens [Richard Stevens], of which Thomas Howard [sic: Thomas Hord] was Lieut. & enlisted the deponent. The said Company was part of the tenth Virginia Reg't. on Continental Establishment, General Weeden [sic: George Weedon] commanded the Brigade. The deponent was in the Encampment at Valley Forge [winter 1777-78], & fought at the Battle of Monmouth [28 Jun 1778], in Gen'l. [Charles] Scott's Brigade. The deponent served three years in the revolutionary army & was honorably discharged. The discharge is lost. The deponent is poor, & in need of the Assistance from his Country for support. [Certified 13 May 1818.]

NOTE: On 8 May 1819 John Dunn, Sr. certified Joshua Dunn's enlistment for three years.
