Pension Application of Thomas Allmand S46540 Transcribed and annotated by C. Leon Harris

For the Purpose of obtaining the Benefits of an Act entitled "An act for the relief of certain surviving Officers and soldiers of the Army of the revolution approved on the fifteenth May 1828, I Thomas Allmand of the County of Stewart and State of Tennessee do hereby declare, that I enlisted in the continental Line of the Army of the Revolution, for and during the War and continued in its Service until its Termination, at which period I was a Private in Captain Fard Oneals [sic: Ferdinand O'Neal's] Company (commanded by Colo. Henry Lee, (Lees Legion) of the Virginia Line. and I also declare, that I afterwards receive a Certificate for the reward of eighty dollars to which I was entitled under a resolve of Congress passed the 15th of May 1778.

And I further declare that I was not on the fifteenth of May 1828 on the Pension List of the United States. Witness my hand this 30^{th} day of August the year of our Lord 1828 —
