The Indent is dated June 27th 1792 and was “delivered to John Hood this INDENTED CERTIFICATE, for the Sum of Two Pounds Eight Shillings and Six pence Sterling being for Thirty four Days duty in the Militia in 1781 & 1782.”]

[p 18: Image of the reverse of the Indent but it bears no markings whatsoever.]
